


Issue 2 - 2024



Birstall Library Comic Book Project

Over the last 5 months we have been undertaking a Comic Book project at Birstall Library. Jessi Illustrates, our fabulous Creative Practitioner, worked with two groups of children: an after-school group for 7-11 year olds and their families who named themselves 'Comic Creators', and Hallam Fields Primary School's Year 4 class, whose alter ego became 'The Bunch of 30 Badgers'!



We held a series of 5 workshops with each group, in which Jessi taught them all things comic book, from facial expressions to speech bubbles, and from backgrounds to story structure. At the end of these workshops, we held a very special Celebration, where the results of their hard work were revealed. A fabulously funny comic book in which each child had their comic strip published, a colourful and vibrant art exhibition, and an interactive magnetic Comic Book Wall that will remain in the library to inspire more potential comic book artists!
